- ◆ He has pursued peaks in the Alaska Range, Andes, Himalayas, Coast Range, Rockies, Sierras, Tien Shan and the Pamirs.
- ◆ In the summer of 2003, Kellogg set the speed record on Denali via the West Buttress.
- ◆ On August 1, 2003 Chad won the prestigious Khan Tengri speed climbing competition in 6 hours 11 minutes round trip
- ◆ Longer-range goals include speed ascents on 8,000-meter peaks and alpine style first ascents

- ◆ Fisherman for 18 years, avid skier for 33 years & even more avid climber for 15 years
- ◆ 11 El Cap Routes, 1 A5 FA on Yosemite Falls Wall
- ◆ Ice/mix climbing for 13 years, including numerous first ascents of modern mixed routes both in Canada and Washington.
- ◆ Multiple first ascents of aid and free routes in Washington.
- ◆ First ascent of Washington's first M8 and M9
- ◆ Speed and first free ascent of New York Gully on N. face of Mt. Snoqualmie.
- ◆ Interested in the development of Modern Mixed routes in the Cascades and inspiring others to expand their vision from the crags to long routes.
